Insurgo Theater Movement to open at the Plaza Hotel and Casino Local repertory company will open in a new theater, offering entertainment in addition to Plaza's classic showroom

LAS VEGAS (July 29, 2011) – In addition to the classic showroom just off the casino floor at the Plaza Hotel and Casino, a new 75-seat theater on the third floor is being developed for the Insurgo Theater Movement.

The award-winning Insurgo Theater Movement is a 36-member repertory company that has garnered a reputation for provocative stagings of classic plays and bold original work. The company will relocate to a newly renovated space at the Plaza Hotel and Casino as of Sept. 1, with the gala opening of "Waiting for Godot."

The opening of the Insurgo Theater Movement at the Plaza marks the first time a local repertory theater has been offered a residency and will produce full seasons of shows at a major hotel-casino in Las Vegas.

"The all-new Plaza wants to offer a unique mix of dining and entertainment options to its customers, both tourists and locals," said Tony Santo, president and CEO of PlayLV and Santo Gaming. "As the Plaza is a neighbor to The Smith Center, we have a great opportunity to be part of a growing downtown arts scene with the opening of the Insurgo Theater Movement."

"The opening the Insurgo Theater Movement at the Plaza is another example of the development of downtown and the growth of the local independent theater and arts scene in Las Vegas," said John Beane, director of the Insurgo Theater Movement.

"Waiting for Godot" by Samuel Beckett will open for previews Sept. 1 and offer an extended run starting Sept. 8, with shows playing Thursday through Saturday at 8 p.m.

In addition, the Insurgo Theater Movement will host Jeremy Aluma's original clown troupe "Four Clowns" on its first national tour for a special engagement on Sept. 2 and 3 at 11 p.m.

Later in the fall, "Cannibal!" by "Book of Mormon" and "South Park" creators Trey Parker and Matt Stone will open for an open-ended run.
