Plaza Hotel & Casino to start multi-million dollar pool renovation

The project will also include resurfacing and maintenance to the iconic downtown Las Vegas property's 70,000 sq. ft. pool deck.

The renovations, performed by Breslin Builders, will occur over the next several months. More details about specific amenities and programming will be announced when the new rooftop pool reopens summer 2016.
