Ticket prices are \$30 for General Admission with 100 rounds of paintballs, and \$45 for VIP, which offers guests priority boarding on to the bus and 300 rounds of paintballs. Prices are plus taxes and fees. Children ages 5 to 12 are permitted with an adult admission, and children under 5 years of age are not permitted.
