## PLAZA HOTEL & CASINO HONORED AT COMMUNITIES IN SCHOOL'S POWER WITHIN AWARDS BREAKFAST

Since then, each month Plaza team members volunteer at Communities In School's mobile food pantry and hand out 50 pounds to each of the 300 Sunrise Acres families who visit the pantry. Additionally, The Plaza has made donations for school uniforms and for a trip for students to go to Wet 'N Wild.
