Talented entertainers are welcome to audition for the role. The open "Broad-casting" call is scheduled for Thursday, Nov. 17, from noon until 3 p.m., and Saturday, Nov. 19, from 4 p.m. until 7 p.m., inside the Plaza's showroom off of the casino floor.
